This letter is to notify you that the City of West Haven Fair Rent Commission will hold a hearing on the enclosed Complaint Docket #25-002, Tuesday, April 15, 2025, at 6:00PM in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 355 Main Street, West Haven, Connecticut. If you are unable to attend the healing in person, you may choose to participate via Zoom. Please contact the Commission prior to the hearing date so to advise and a Zoom link will be emailed to you.

The parties may be represented by a person of their choosing at this hearing and should ensure their representatives have a copy of this notice. Parties will be given an opportunity to present testimony, witnesses, exhibits, and provided an opportunity to cross-examine witnesses, examine docwllents offered into evidence, and a limited time to offer arguments.

Witnesses will testify under oath, and the hearing will be recorded. The Fair Rent Commission will render a decision within 60 days of closing the evidentiary portion of the hearing. A party may request a translator; which may be provided at the Commission's sole discretion if a translator is available. A party may also bring a translator to the hearing.

A request for a continuance will be granted under limited circumstances. Each party has the right to request one continuance of a scheduled hearing. If requested by mail or email the opposing party must provide a copy of the request to all parties and representatives. A continuance will also be granted upon mutual agreement of the parties. Finally, a request for continuance may be granted, in the Commission's sole discretion, if it finds the scheduled hearing date poses a hardship to either party such that the Commission detemlines a continuance is justified.
