Commissioner Kane stated the Fire Marshall has been contacted and work will need to be inspected. If there is contamination, all work must ceased and be corrected. This application is for the removal of the tank and does not cover the installation, which requires another application. Robert Pimer stated an A-2 was done by an engineer. The work will commence immediately upon approval. Frank Pepe informed the commission of the process that will be done. There will be five tests done before any dirt will be put back into the ground. Commissioner Saldibar made a motion to approve File #17-001 with all the requirements by the Fire Marshall and Planning and Zoning Office, seconded by Commissioner Gilbane and passed.
