“With tonight’s resignation we will be staffed at 113 officers. We are minus 3 Officers in Police Academy, 2 Officers on FTO, 1 Lieutenant and 1 Officer out injured, 3 Officers on Light Duty, which leaves us a total of 103 available Officers.

The officer at POSTC Academy graduates in July 2022. The other two will start Milford’s Academy on April 21st, 2022.

We are currently doing background checks on two lateral hires and 1 recruit, who if hired will attend Milford’s Academy starting in two weeks.”
