

## MINUTES OF THE W.P.C.C. MEETING

4/6/2022

The regular meeting /public hearing of the West Haven Water Pollution Control Commission was held on April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022 . In attendance were Commissioners, Bill Canning, Andrea Talamelli, Rich DePalma, Stuart Rosenkrantz, Mark Magri, Plant Administrator, Abdul Quadir, City Engineer and Paul Butler, plant employee.

Bill Canning opened up the Public Hearing portion of meeting @ 6:00 pm. per legal notice which appeared in the New Haven Register on 3/25/2022, regarding the budget, asking if anyone from the Public wished to speak, asking for the second time and third and final time. Bill Canning made a motion to close the Public Hearing @ 6:02 pm, all were in favor.

Old Business

Bill Canning opened up the regular meeting @ 6:03 pm and asked to make a motion to accept the minutes from the 3/2/2022 meeting. Andrea Talamelli made the motion and Rich DePalma seconded it. All were in favor.

Bill Canning brought up new Sewer Connection Fees, new construction \$3,000, residential, and \$4,000 Commercial and \$70.00 for permit. This matter has been tabled until next month. Everyone was in agreement.

Bill Canning mentioned the purchase of the new Vector Truck, with ARPA funding. It will cost \$50,000 more for the more powerful engine & heavy duty chasis.

It was mentioned that there is a grant for \$175,000 for a study on anerobic digester.

The plans for new development for the Orange Sanitary Sewer, were discussed but the Commission would like to meet with Orange and discuss in detail.

There was a motion to adjourn made by Andrea Talamelli at 7:46 pm, and Stuart Rosenkrantz seconded it. All were in favor.
