## **Additional Food Service Fees:**

### **QFO violation fee**

Failure to designate and/or maintain a QFO approved by the Director of Health or agent within 60 days of the QFO deficiency shall result in a \$50.00 fee in addition to suspension of the food establishment's license. An additional \$50.00 shall be assessed for each further 30 day period. Failure to pay fines within 5 working days shall be cause for suspension of license to operate.

(Pursuant to CT Public Health Code 19-13-B48-49, 19-13B-42(S)(4), B48(j)(3), B49(t)(3))

### **Repeat violation fines**

If a four point violation or inspection score lower than 80 is given, a follow-up re-inspection is required. If a second re-inspection is required for the same four point violation or another failing score then a \$100.00 re-inspection fee shall be assessed as well as any specified penalty fines. Any violation of the Public Health Code noted on an inspection must be corrected before the next scheduled inspection (2 weeks). The payment of assessed fines shall not be a substitute or alternative to correction of the cited violation. Failure to pay said failure fee within five (5) working days will result in a fine of \$100.00 each day thereafter. A \$50.00 fee will be assessed to reopen a food establishment that is closed due to an inspection failure.

### **Temporary event late fee**

Any application received less than 10 business days prior to the event will be subject to a late fee of \$50.00.
