



City of West Haven Beach Parking Guidelines

Nonresident Parking — Pay by kiosk at the following locations:

- Sea Bluff parking lot, Ocean Avenue.
- Bradley Point parking lot, Captain Thomas Boulevard.
- Palace Street, between Altschuler Boulevard and Oak Street.
- Morse Park parking lot, Beach Street.
- Sandy Point parking lot, Beach Street.

Fees: \$2.50 per hour/\$25 per day. Annual nonresident parking passes can be purchased in person or by mail for \$250 through the Department of Human Resources, second floor, City Hall, 355 Main St. A valid driver's license and vehicle registration are required. Checks are payable to the City of West Haven. Cash is also accepted, but for walk-ins only.

Resident Parking — In addition to Sea Bluff, Bradley Point, Morse Park and Sandy Point, residents can park in the following lots:

- South Street.
- Dawson Avenue.
- Rock Street (Savin Rock Conference Center — until further notice).
- Oak Street.
- Altschuler Boulevard.

Palace Street parking is by kiosk ticket only. Residents must have a valid beach parking sticker affixed to the inside lower left corner of the vehicle's windshield. Beach stickers are available through the tax office by calling 203-937-3525. Driver's licenses and vehicle registrations are not accepted in parking lots — a valid, affixed beach sticker is required. Beach stickers are required at all times, regardless if parking lots are staffed.

Boat Launch Parking: The April Street boat launch is usable by residents and nonresidents. Residents must display a valid beach sticker; nonresidents can purchase time at the kiosk. Parking in the lot is for vehicles with trailers only. There is a limited amount of vehicle-only parking spaces to the left of the boat launch. Any vehicle parked in the lot without a trailer is subject to a ticket and tow.

Hours of Operation

The following parking lots are open daily from 6 a.m. to a half-hour after sunset: South Street, Dawson Avenue, Sea Bluff, Morse Park.

The following parking lots are open daily from 6 a.m.-10:30 p.m.: Bradley Point, Rock Street (Savin Rock Conference Center), Oak Street, Altschuler Boulevard, Palace Street, Sandy Point.

The April Street boat launch is open 24/7 for vehicles with trailers. Limited vehicle-only parking spaces are available from 6 a.m. to a half-hour after sunset.

The boardwalk/bike path, between Altschuler Boulevard and Washington Avenue, is closed daily from 10 p.m.-7 a.m., per an agreement between the City of West Haven and the Savin Rock Condominium Association at West Walk.
